C. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Eligibility

1. The Competition is open to **public and all primary and secondary school students** within the Council of the City of Kuching South area.
2. The Competition has two categories:

Primary: Ages 6 to 12

Secondary: Ages 13 to 17

Competition Period

1. The Competition **starts on 19th June 2024** and **ends on 8th July 2024**.
2. The application form can be obtained from **MBKS's Security Counter** or downloaded from MBKS's official website at **<https://mbks.sarawak.gov.my/web/home/index/>**.
3. All application forms and paper mache cats must be received by **Monday, 8th July 2024, on or before 4:00 PM**.

How to Enter

1. Participants must create a paper mache cats **made entirely of recycled papers** and including the completed application forms and a brief description of the sculpture.
2. Each participant may submit only one entry.
3. Completed application forms and the paper mache cat must be **submitted to 3rd Floor, PRCD Unit at MBKS**. Please do not hesitate to contact **Mr. Ting Tiew Lik at 010-9223705** for more information.

Submission Guidelines

1. The paper mache cat must be made entirely of recycled papers, with no other materials used. The paper mache cat can either be painted or unpainted.
2. The paper mache cat should not exceed the following dimensions:

Height: 30 cm

Length: 20 cm

Width: 20 cm

3. The paper mache cat should be an original creation and not previously submitted in any other competitions.
4. All participants must write down their full name as per their IC and the name of their school (for participants via school) and contact number at the bottom of their paper mache cat for identification purposes.

Judging Criteria

1. Entries will be judged based on creativity, originality, craftsmanship, and adherence to the recycled papers-only material requirement.
2. The decision of the judging panel is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Prizes

1. The prizes for the Competition are as follows:

1. Participants retain ownership of their sculptures, but the Organizer reserves the right to use photos and the cat sculptures of the entries for promotional and marketing purposes, including the Malaysia Book of Records submission.

2. The Organizer is not responsible for any damage, loss, or injury resulting from participation in the Competition or acceptance of a prize.
