REFLEXOLOGY & HEALTH ESTABLISHMENTS (Massage, Spa, Reflexology, etc)

Health & Licensing Requirements On Building Plan:-

- No part of the premise shall be used or occupied as sleeping quarters, preparation or cooking of food for sale to the customer.
- 2. To state the usage of the parts of the premise that is not use for reflexology and health establishment.
- 3. The floor shall be finished with durable, material capable of withstanding disinfection and easily maintained, clean, to the standard set by the Council.
- 4. To provide water closet (w.c.) as per schedule A attached for both male and female if it is located in a shop house (as per schedule A attached) unless the Council is satisfied that in the circumstances of any particular case the provision of such separate sanitary convenience is unnecessary, floor shall be tiled and walls to be glazed tiles all round to ceiling height, wash hand basin shall be provided with soap dispenser, hand dryer and the wall behind the wash hand basin shall be tiled.
- 5. The premise shall have sufficient lighting and ventilation.
- 6. If the premise is provided with air-conditioning, the minimum capacity of the air-conditioner shall be 176 BTU to 1 m³ and extractor fan shall be provided.
- 7. To provide receptacles for soiled towels & trade wastes.
- 8. General layout with number of room, bed & chair, etc to be shown.
- 9. Room or cubicle, etc must have ¼ of the door constructed with a transparent glass. Curtain or screen to separate the beds shall not exceed 2 metre in height measured from the floor.
- 10. There shall be no direct access from the inside of the licensed premise to the other non-licensed premise.
