THE KUCHING MUNICIPAL COUNCIL (LICENSING OF MISCELLANEOUS
OCCUPATIONS) BY-LAWS

(Made under section 100)

[1st June, 1961]

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kuching Municipal Council (Licensing of Miscellaneous Occupations) By-laws. Citation.

2.—(1) Any person who carries on any of the trades or businesses specified in the First Column of the First Schedule except under and in accordance with the provisions of a licence issued by the Council and at the place, if any, specified in the licence shall be guilty of an offence: Penalty, a fine of fifty dollars for the first offence, and, in the case of a second or subsequent offence, a fine of one hundred dollars. Licences in respect of certain trades or businesses.

(2) There shall be payable in respect of licences to carry on the trades and businesses referred to in paragraph (1) the appropriate fees set out in the Second Column of the First Schedule.

3.—(1) Any person who sells alcoholic liquor except under and in accordance with the provisions of a licence issued by the Council and at the place specified in the licence shall be guilty of an offence: Penalty, a fine of one hundred dollars for the first offence, and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, a fine of one hundred and fifty dollars. Licences to sell alcoholic liquor.

(2) There shall be payable in respect of the licences to sell alcoholic liquor specified in the First Column of the Second Schedule the appropriate fees set out in the Second Column of that Schedule.

4.—(1) Licences may be issued on the payment of the appropriate fee and shall— Period of licences and renewal.

(a) in the case of a yearly licence, expire on the 31st day of December; and

(b) in the case of a quarterly licence, expire on the 31st day of March, the 30th day of June, the 30th day of September or the 31st day of December, whichever first comes after the date of issue.

(2) Any yearly or quarterly licence renewed within forty-two days of the date of expiry shall be deemed to be renewed with effect from the date of expiry.

THE CITY OF KUCHING SOUTH
(LICENSING OF MISCELLANEOUS OCCUPATIONS)
(AMENDMENT) BY-LAWS, 1997

(Made under section 100)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 100 of the Kuching Municipal Ordinance as modified by section 4(1) of the City of Kuching Ordinance, 1988, to apply to the City of Kuching South, the Council of the City of Kuching South has, in compliance with the provisions of Part XI of the Kuching Municipal Ordinance and with the approval of the Minister, made the following By-laws:

1.—(1) These By-laws may be cited as the **City of Kuching South (Licensing of Miscellaneous Occupations) (Amendment) By-laws, 1997**, and shall come into force on such date as the Council may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Citation, commencement and application.

(2) These By-laws shall apply only to the area of the City of Kuching South.

2. The Kuching Municipal Council (Licensing of Miscellaneous Occupations) By-laws are amended by inserting immediately after by-law 1 the following new by-law 1A:

“Interpretation.

1A. In these By-laws—

“alcoholic liquor” includes all forms of wine and beer;

“Council” means the Council of the City of Kuching South;

“food establishment” means any place other than a school canteen where food is prepared, cooked, served or exposed for sale for human consumption;

“food stall” means any facility, whether movable or not, used for the preparation, sale, display or serving of food to the public, placed within an area not exceeding 3.3 square metres per facility;

“non-food processing factory” means any premises where non-food items are manufactured, processed or assembled;

“sundry or provision shop” includes any premises used for the sale of canned food, cereal, meat, fish, poultry, vegetables and fruits;

“village shop” means any fixed premises used for the purpose of trade within a traditional native village or kampung.”.

3. By-law 2(1) of the Principal By-laws is amended—

(a) by substituting for the words “fifty dollars” in the fifth and sixth lines the words “five hundred ringgit”; and

(b) by substituting for the words “one hundred dollars” in the last line the words “one thousand ringgit”.

4. By-law 3(1) of the Principal By-laws is amended—

(a) by substituting for the words “one hundred dollars” in the fourth line the words “one thousand ringgit” and

(b) by substituting for the words “one hundred and fifty dollars” in the last line the words “one thousand and five hundred ringgit”.
